







# 2025 Explorium Fall Report

Since the start of the new year, our programs have continued with exciting growth and impact. We're excited to share a few highlights from our work and to give you a glimpse into what's next.

### **Summer Day Camp**

The summer was filled with exciting adventures, and several new activities. Many of the program additions are just the foundation for future success. Below are just a few highlights.

- Served 320 campers with approximately 70% being enrolled in Summit School District;
- An 10% increase in distributed scholarship funding totaling \$11,969 in scholarship distributions;
- We added kayaks, giving campers the chance to learn new outdoor skills and build independence;
- Included an overnight option, "Night at the Museum," that included kayaking, a museum visit, and a sunrise celebration.

# **School Year Programs**

It's been an amazing start to the 2025-26 school year. Below are just a few highlights.

- 72% of the Upper Blue and 34% of the Breckenridge after school students qualify for free & reduced lunch;
- Supporting an increased special needs student body through increased staff training and improved teacher to student classroom ratio;
- A revitalized suite of STEM Enrichment programs funded by a variety of community funders.









# **Internship Program**

In the winter of 2025, we launched a paid internship program that provided two students, Josceline Ortega and Sheccid Ramirez Solís, with extensive training and hands-on experience. Both have now successfully begun their freshman year of college, pursuing degrees in education.
